



COUNCIL OF LEGAL EDUCATION NOTICE TO STUDENTS – 2021 ANNUAL ENTRANCE EXAMINATIONS

The Council of Legal Education has approved the following recommendation of the Admissions Board:

- 1) In view of the continuing pandemic, the traditional format of face-to-face invigilated examinations to determine placement at the Council of Legal Education (Council) law schools, will be cancelled in 2021.
- 2) Face-to face invigilated examinations will be replaced by an evaluation of the transcript of the Applicant's Bachelor of Laws (LLB) degree in order to ensure that, in accordance with the requirements of Article 3 of the Agreement Establishing the Council of Legal Education, 1971, the degree is recognized as equivalent to the LLB from the University of the West Indies
- 3) Only transcripts which have been received by July 31, 2021 will be considered.
- 4) The LLB degree of each applicant will be ranked in order of the Class/GPA for purposes of determining priority for placement at one of the Council's law schools.
- 5) Applicants will be offered a place (subject to the availability of spaces at the laws schools), based on the class/GPA of their degree.
- 6) Applicants who are not awarded a place will be required to re-apply.
