Legal Education Certificate - Two Year Programme

Applications are invited from holders of a first degree in Law obtained from a recognized institution in a common law jurisdiction (in accordance with Article 3 of the Treaty Establishing the Council of Legal Education), or holders of the Common Professional Examination Certificate or Graduate Diploma in Law from a recognized institution (UK) together with vocational training, and who wish to be considered for selection for the Two-Year Legal Education Certificate Programme. **ALL APPLICANTS** will be required to sit an entrance examination which will be held in July 2017.

This is not applicable to holders of the University of the West Indies LL.B. degree.

This examination is intended to assist with determining priority placing to the Law Schools and **IS SUBJECT TO SPACE AVAILABILITY.**

The examination will consist of testing in basic core courses. The courses are:

- Law of Contract
- Law of Tort
- Real Property
- Equity
- Criminal Law

CANDIDATES MUST ATTAIN A MINIMUM PASS MARK OF 40% IN EACH OF THE FIVE COURSES.
