Council of Legal Education (Amendment) Regulations, 2022

Pursuant to regulation 64 of the Council of Legal Education Regulations (referred to as "the Principal Regulations") the Council of Legal Education makes the following regulations-

1. These Regulations, which amend the Council of Legal Education Regulations, may be cited as the Council of Legal Education (Amendment) Regulations, 2022.
2. Regulation 36 of the Principal Regulations is amended by deleting paragraph (4) and replacing it with the following -

" (4) Notwithstanding paragraph (3), a student who fails in only one subject in the supplementary assessments or examinations in the second year of study will be permitted to re-sit the assessments and examinations in that subject only in the following year without being required to repeat the entire second year of study, and upon passing that subject shall be deemed to have passed the whole of the second year assessments and examinations.

(4A) A student who fails to pass a subject after re-sitting it pursuant to paragraph (4) shall be required to repeat the entire second year of study and to re-sit the whole second year assessments and examinations."
