

COUNCIL OF LEGAL EDUCATION

Council of Legal Education (Amendment) Regulations, 2021

Pursuant to regulation 64 of the Council of Legal Education Regulations (referred to as “the Principal Regulations”) the Council of Legal Education makes the following regulations-

1. These Regulations, which amend the Council of Legal Education Regulations, may be cited as the Council of Legal Education (General) (Amendment) Regulations, 2021.
2. Regulation 35 of the Principal Regulations is amended by deleting paragraph (5) and replacing it with the following -

“(5) A student who has failed to pass all of the subjects whether tested by -

- (a) examinations only;
- (b) assessments only; and
- (c) assessments and examinations,

in the first year, after having repeated the first year, shall –

- (i) if he fails in only one subject in the supplementary assessment or examinations, proceed into the second year of study and the subject failed in the first year of study shall with respect to that student be deemed to form part of his course of study in the second year;
- (ii) if he fails in two subjects in the supplementary assessment or examinations, not be permitted to continue his course of study for the Certificate.”.

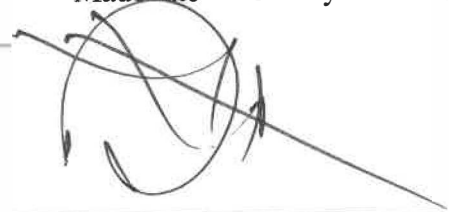
3. Regulation 36 of the Principal Regulations is amended by inserting immediately after paragraph (3), the following as paragraph (3A) –

“(3A) Notwithstanding paragraph (3), where a student has –

- (a) proceeded into the second year of study pursuant to regulation 35(4);
and
- (b) passed the first-year subject that formed part of his course of study in the second year,

the first-year subject passed shall not be deemed to form a part of his course of study if that student is required to repeat the entire second year course of study and to re-sit the whole second year assessments and examinations pursuant to paragraph (3).”.
